

## 1. RICS Accreditation

- For APC purposes a student must show that they have 'ethics' to Level 3:
  - Level 1 General awareness of the subject in the marketplace.
  - Level 2 How ethics is addressed in their area of work.
  - Level 3 Show evidence of how the student complies with RICS ethical standards in their everyday work.
- We need to show evidence that in every RICS accredited programme we are delivering 'ethics' to level 3.
- Accreditation on 31 July next.

## 3. Ethics & Academic Integrity

### Collusion

- Turnitin high levels of similarity across assignments.
- Increased number of assignments going to Academic Misconduct Panels due to apparent collusion.
- Involving groups of students working in larger firms.
- Discussions ongoing with key employers.

## 4. Update on 'HELP' and RICS validation

HELP – 'Higher Engagement Lower Pressure'

- UCEM are undertaking a high-level cross programme review to identify areas where topics can be removed or lightened and where any structural changes can be made. Repetition? Optional or core?.
- We aim to remove some of our students' barriers to success.
- Review of where 'Ethics' sits on various modules
